- Mission statement:

- Lawmakers/policymakers
- Final authority on how laws or regulations are implemented

Is a searchable database of questions asked by members and answered by NASFAA staff

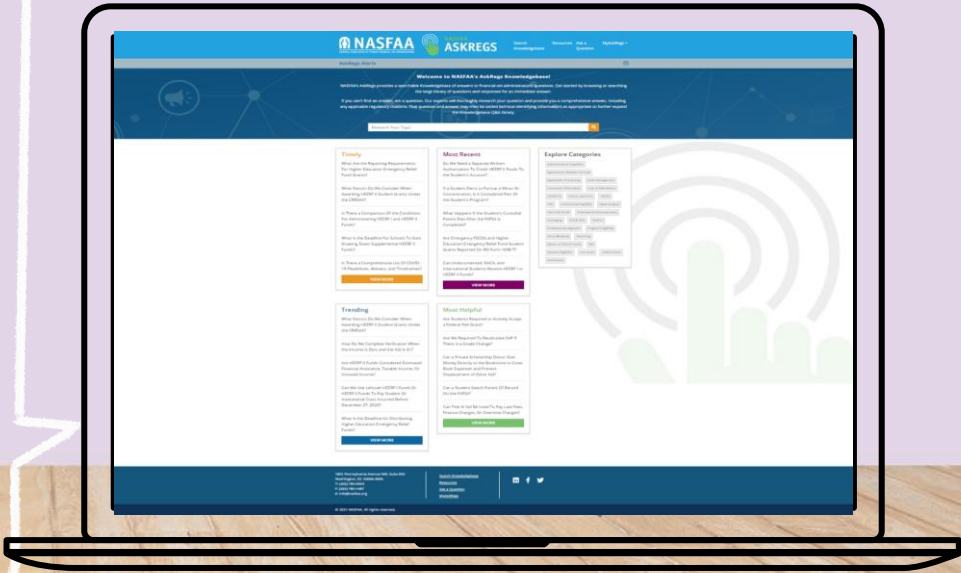


Is a very useful tool when researching an issue, especially when you are unsure of which rules apply to your specific scenario

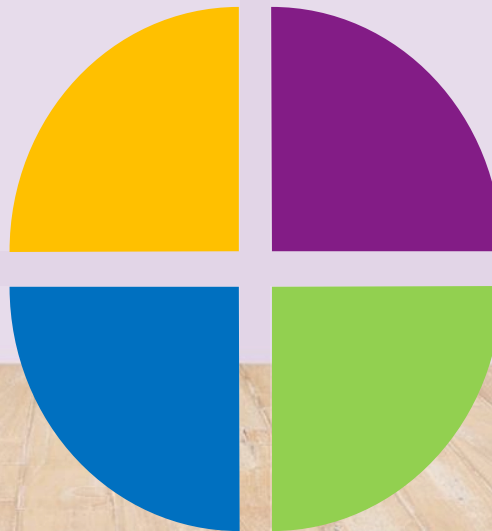
